# Vote June 29th in the Annexation Referendum Election


In December 2009, the northwest part of the Town of Bristol was incorporated into the Village of Bristol after a referendum election. Earlier this year, the Village of Bristol petitioned the Kenosha County Circuit Court in an effort to afford the electors of the remaining Town of Bristol with the opportunity to vote on whether or not they wish to annex to the Village of Bristol. On May 17th, 2010 Judge Bruce E. Schroeder signed an Order directing that an Annexation Referendum Election be held in the Town of Bristol on June 29, 2010. Electors of the Town of Bristol will cast their ballots on the question of whether they are FOR OR AGAINST the annexation of the Town of Bristol into the Village of Bristol. The Annexation Referendum Election will be held on June 29th, 2010 at the Holy Cross Church (formerly St. Scholastica), 18700-116th Street, located on Hwy Q, just west of Hwy 45. All Town of Bristol Electors are encouraged to get out and vote on June 29th.

A **PUBLIC MEETING will be held on June 17th, 2010 at 7:00 pm** at the Bristol Municipal Building 19801 83<sup>rd</sup> Street. Please come with any questions or comments you may have regarding the Referendum Election.

# Sample of referenda question for the June 29th Referendum

To vote on the referenda question, the elector shall check the box next to "For Annexation" if in favor of the Town becoming a Village, or the elector shall check the box next to "Against Annexation" if opposed to the Town becoming a Village.

# **Summer Safety**

We recommend you have a Carbon Monoxide (CO) detector at your residence in the sleeping area. CO is a colorless, odorless gas that can kill you if there is a problem with gas appliances or the chimney flue is blocked.

Remember to check your smoke detectors on a monthly basis and practice Exit Drills with a predetermined meeting place outside your residence.
