COUNTY HIGHWAY U TO CLOSE

Kenosha County is underway with the reconstruction of the County Highway Q (104th Street) and County Highway U (136th Avenue) intersection which began in early October 2021 with a scheduled completion of late fall 2022. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of the project.

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 7:

• County Highway U (136th Avenue), just south of County Highway Q (104th Street), is scheduled to close to traffic for approximately two days, while crews work to perform asphalt paving and pavement markings.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8:


• County Highway U (136th Avenue), just north of County Highway Q (104th Street), is scheduled to close to traffic for approximately one day, while crews work to perform pavement markings.

Motorists should plan ahead and use an alternate route to avoid delays.

Detour Route:

- → Motorists are encouraged to utilize County Highway Q (104th Street), County Highway MB (160th Avenue), County Highway C (Wilmot Road), and County Highway U (136th Avenue) to get around the northern County Highway U (136th Avenue) closure.
- → Motorists are encouraged to utilize County Highway U (136th Avenue), County Highway CJ (Horton Road), County Highway MB (152nd Avenue), County Highway Q (104th Street) to get around the southern County Highway U (136th Avenue) closure.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.
