#### GRASS IN THE STREETS

The village is seeing an increased number of residents who are mowing grass into the streets. Please be conscious when mowing to blow the grass into your yard and not into the street. Grass clippings not only make the streets look messy, but they clog the storm sewers.



If public works needs to come sweep in front of your house, you will be assessed a minimum fine of \$50.00

### NOTICE: All vehicles must be properly licensed!!

Per Village Ordinance 10-5-8 Junked Vehicles and Appliances on Private Property, No disassembled, inoperable, **unlicensed**, junked or wrecked motor vehicles, truck bodies, tractors, trailers, farm machinery, vehicle parts or tires, or appliances shall be stored upon private residential property or unenclosed within a building upon nonresidential property within the Village of Cobb for a period exceeding ten (10) days.

There is an increased number of unlicensed vehicles parked on properties in the village. Please have these vehicles properly licensed, or have them removed. *If no action is taken, Iowa County Sheriff's Department will be issuing citations.*

#### Please remember:



- Cobb has a 2 dog ordinance, this will be enforced by the lowa County Sheriff's Department
- Per Wisconsin Law, all dogs must be licensed each calendar year. Failure to do so will result in a fine.
- Please keep your dog(s) on your property. Dogs that are not trained to stay on your property must be on a leash or inside a fence.
- When walking your dog, please be courteous of other village residents and pick up after your dog!

#### What is the Public Fire Protection Charge?

This is a charge that is required by State law, and regulated by the State of Wisconsin's Public Service Commission. This is a cost collected for the benefit of municipal water utilities for the express purpose of recovering the costs to supply proper volume & pressure for fighting fires.

#### How has Public Fire Protection been paid in the past?

The Village has been using property tax dollars to subsidize the utility at the rate of approximately \$40,795/ year for facilities in the Village of Cobb.

#### Why is this now going to show up as a fee on my Utility Bill?

The Public Service Commission increased the rate to \$52,956 beginning in 2019. The Village can no longer afford to subsidize the entire payment with the use of property taxes. Utility customers will now have to pay for a service that was previously subsidized by only the Village's property taxpayers.
