DON'T FORGET YOUR DOG LICENSE!

Dog license renewal is done annually. A completed application and a copy of the current rabies certificate must be provided to the clerk for the new tag to be issued. Cost is \$15 for male or female dogs and \$10 for spayed or neutered dogs. By village ordinance, all dogs residing in the village must be



<u>licensed</u>. After March 31, a \$20 late fee is collected. Do not delay, license your dog TODAY!!
