WINTER PARKING No Parking 2 am to 6 am November 15 to March

15. By ordinance, this is a requirement for village residents and guests. Parking Tickets are \$25 and can be



issued whether there is a snow event happening or not. License plate registrations are suspended after 30 days, if the ticket is not paid. Tickets need to be paid to the Village and can be left in the Drop Box at Village Hall.

VILLAGE BOARD MEETINGS VIA ZOOM

The Village Board now holds it monthly meetings via ZOOM on the computer. The agenda is posted with the Zoom link on the village website. Everyone is welcome to attend the meeting and listen to the business in front of the Board of Trustees. ZOOM is free to use and meetings are open to the public, meetings begin at 6:30 pm.

ELECTION-FEBRUARY 16, 2021

Primary election for Superintendent of Public Instruction will be held on Tuesday February 16, 2021. In-person Absentee Voting starts February 2. Seven candidates are in the running for one position. The two candidates with the highest vote count will move on to the April 6th election. Polls open at 7 am and close at 8 pm.
