Ordinance Chapter 298 covers Fireworks, permits required, fines, penalties, and parental liability. BE INFORMED, because not knowing the rules is not an excuse if you get



caught. Fireworks are dangerous and illegal! Be Safe!!

Dogs - Tagged? Leashed?



All dog over the age of 5 months who reside in the Village of Dane must be licensed. This is a state law, county law, and by Village ordinance. Please get your dogs licensed as soon as possible each year. And please keep your pet on a leash when you are out and

about in the Village. If you are a new resident to the Village or adopt a new pet, you have 60 days to apply for their license.

Building Permits REQUIRED

Building Projects like fences, some sheds, electrical improvements, and plumbing changes require an application for a building permit. The Village of Dane has a contract with General Engineering Company and Mary Dussling is our assigned inspector. Please contact Mary at 608-697-8003, if you have questions about any projects you are thinking of starting. The permit application is available online or from the



Village Clerk's Office. Checking the village ordinances will assist you, too. Starting a building project without getting a permit will double the cost of the permit.

Single Stream Recycling

With carted curbside recycling collection, all items can be placed loose and separately in your cart. It is especially important that you do not place plastic bags or plastic food wrap in



with your recycling items. Plastic bags cause a significant problem for most processing facilities in Wisconsin. Plastic grocery bags can be taken to designated retail drop-off locations around the area.
