FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING IN OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER

All fire hydrants in the village will be flushed during October and November.
This process is part of fire hydrant maintenance. Discoloration of water or air in the water lines can happen after the flushing occurs. Please allow the water to run for a brief period to alleviate either issue. You may notice a change in water pressure while hydrants are flushed. The water pressure should return to normal once flushing is complete in your area.

BRANCH AND LIMB COLLECTION



Branch and Limb collection is scheduled for the second Tuesday in October and November. No branch and limbs will be collected in December. Any limbs planned for collection should be on the curb by 7am on the scheduled pick-up day. Guidelines are posted on the village website if you need more information on placing limbs on the curb for collection.
