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Membership

The Municipal Projects & Property Committee consists of five members. Two members shall be Village Trustees. Three members shall be residents of the Village who shall be persons with municipal zoning and infrastructure knowledge, as well as an understanding of federal, state, and local regulations, along with construction and maintenance experience.

Duties and Functions

1. Provide recommendations to the Village Board on policies, projects, and priorities for public works, municipal projects, and capital improvements as directed by the Village Board.
2. Provide recommendations to the Village Board concerning maintenance and repair of public infrastructure, including roads, culverts, storm and sanitary sewers, and public buildings as directed by the Village Board.
3. As directed by the Village Board, provide recommendations to it concerning public works projects such as road improvements and new building construction.

Meetings

- The Committee shall meet, in person, a minimum of once each month.
- The Chair will establish the agenda for all meetings.
- Minutes of the meetings and recommendations of the Committee shall be submitted to the Village Board.
- An affirmative vote of a majority of the members present at a meeting at which a quorum (three persons) is present, shall constitute the action of the Committee.
- Rules of decorum shall be maintained by all members of the Committee. Failure to follow shall be a basis for removal from the Committee.
