RECEIPT OF BIDS: Separate sealed Bids will be received by the Village Clerk, Village of Millbrook, 35 Merritt Avenue, Millbrook, NY 12545 until 7:00 PM Eastern Standard Time on May 8, 2018 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud for the "Ambulance Acquisition for the Millbrook Fire Department Rescue Squad". All bids must be made upon and in accordance with the form of proposals prepared by the Village and shall be submitted in sealed envelopes so marked. The bid concerns the acquisition of a new Ambulance as set forth in the Bid Specifications dated December 18, 2017 entitled "Ambulance Specifications, Millbrook Fire Department Rescue Squad, Millbrook, New York 12545". The Specifications and other Contract Documents may be obtained and reviewed on and after April 9, 2018 at the Office of the Village Clerk, Village of Millbrook, 35 Merritt Avenue, Millbrook, NY 12545. Each bid shall be accompanied by an acceptable form of Bid Deposit Guarantee in the amount of five (5%) percent of the amount bid payable to the Village of Millbrook as a guarantee that if the Bid is accepted, the Bidder will complete the items bid upon in accordance with the specifications and under the terms of the Contract Documents. The Bid Deposit shall be a Certified Check of the bidder or Bid Bond and be drawn payable to the Village of Millbrook.
