BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Millbrook as follows:

Section 1. Legislative intent: In conducting a review of the Village of Millbrook Village Code, the Village Board determined that Article I of Chapter 46 of the Village Code, which imposes Residency Requirements for the position of Village Justice, is obsolete since the Village Court, and the position of Village Justice, had previously been abolished in the Village of Millbrook. The Village Board therefore intends to repeal and remove Article I of Chapter 46 "Residency Requirements" from the Village Code in its entirety, and renumber the remaining Article of Chapter 46 accordingly.

Section 2. The existing Article I "Village Justice" of Chapter 46 "Residency Requirements" of the Village Code of the Village of Millbrook, and all sections and subsections contained within Article I of Chapter 46, is hereby repealed in its entirety and removed from the Village Code.

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<u>Section 3</u>. The remaining Article of Chapter 46, Article II "Clerk, Deputy Clerk, Treasurer, Deputy Treasurer and Public Works Supervisor" shall remain unchanged, but shall be accordingly renumbered as Article I, and the section contained therein renumbered §46-1.

<u>Section 4</u>. This local law shall take effect as of the date of filing with the New York Secretary of State.
