

# MILLBROOK CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT INFO SESSIONS RE: 2024 CAPITAL PROJECT PLAN

MCSD is proposing a major <u>capital improvement</u> <u>project</u> that should be of interest to everyone in the community. Their final info session is scheduled for **5:30pm on March 6th** at the **Union Vale FD Station 1** (2388 NY-82 in Lagrangeville).

## ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AT THE FEBRUARY MEETING

- After additional resident input, the public hearing for the **Short-Term Rental law** was closed (having been kept open from the January meeting), and the board voted unanimously to approve it as proposed. Once the law has been filed with NYS within the next few weeks, we will post the permit application form on our website to begin the registration process.
- Officer-in-Charge Witt, Trustee Contino and I continue to hold weekly meetings with Lexipol to institute a Policies and Procedures manual for the Millbrook Police Department. At last week's board meeting, the trustees approved the "Use of Force" chapter so we could implement and deploy it ASAP. Within the month we expect to have all 20 chapters that constitute "Tier 1" policies available for board review and approval.
- The board approved a 5-year 3.5% bond from Bank of Millbrook to cover the \$121K cost of the new dump truck which will replace a 13-year-old model that has been needing a lot of expensive repair work to stay operational. It will be auctioned for sale once the new vehicle arrives.
- The board approved the Length of Service Award Program (LOSAP) Service Credit List for 2023. LOSAP is a program which allows Fire & Rescue volunteers to earn pension-like benefits based on how active they are in responding to emergency calls. Payments are made after certain years of service and/or after retiring from service.
- Two engineering firms responded to our request for quotes to bid on overseeing the planned upgrade of the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Additional information is being solicited from the respondents to guide us in making a decision within the next month.



## MILLBROOK FIRE DEPT BINGO SOLD OUT!

Bingo returned to the Firehouse this month and I was one of the people turned away from the event because they reached building capacity. Plans are to do this monthly and the next sessions will be on March 8th and April 12th. If interested, my advice is to get there early, doors open at 5pm – Bingo starts at 7pm! ### BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AT THE WATERFALL

Dutchess County has awarded contracts to start work on this project, beginning with removal of trees that are within the easement on the far side of the bridge. Later this Spring, traffic will be rerouted to Harts Village Road for approximately 2 months to complete the replacement.
