FIREMAN'S CARNIVAL & PARADE

Congratulations to President Matt Rochfort, Chief Dominic Boscardin and the entire Millbrook Fire Department for a job well done and for fun times had at this year's carnival and parade. It was great to have the carnival back and we are looking forward to them returning next year.

TRUCK TRAFFIC IN THE VILLAGE

Earlier this month, the Town of Washington signed the <u>Village's proposed</u> IMA, that will redirect large commercial trucks outside of the Village. This will have no effect on pickup trucks and trucks making local deliveries. The IMA is now being reviewed by NYS DOT. Thanks to Supervisor Gary Ciferri and the Town Board members who efficiently expedited and approved this request for the benefit of all residents.

SIDEWALKS/CDBG GRANT

The Village received final approval this month of the **previously announced \$125,000 CDBG grant** to assist with sidewalk and curb repair on the north side of Franklin Ave. Survey work will begin soon, with the tentative plan to go out to bid during winter 2026 for construction to begin in spring/summer 2026. Thanks to County Legislator Deirdre Houston, County Executive Sue Serino and Majority Leader Will Truitt for continuing to support this important work to improve local infrastructure projects by breaking down accessibility barriers for older adults and people with disabilities.

HOMETOWN HEROES/VETERANS GRANT

The Village applied for and <u>won a microgrant</u> through the Dutchess County Office of Veterans Affair. The \$5,000 will be used to start a Hometown Heroes banner program, fulfilling the grant's stated goal of supporting programs that benefit veterans and honor their service. We are still finalizing the cost for each honoree and there will soon be a signup page on the Village website to nominate a loved one for recognition. Again, special thanks to Legislator Houston, County Executive Serino, Majority Leader Truitt and Office of Veterans Services Director Adam Roche for supporting the Village in this important endeavor!
