APPOINTMENT RECOMMENDATION

The Police Department is recommending the appointment of Antoinette Cocozza as a Part-Time Police Officer. Mrs. Cocozza is New York State certified, a graduate of the Ulster County Law Enforcement Training Academy and has prior experience as a full-time municipal police officer, dispatcher, and correction officer with New York State DOCCS. This appointment is part of our ongoing effort to address current staffing shortages and increase personnel levels.






