

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PAVING PROJECT
VILLAGE OF OAKDALE, MONROE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Village of Oakdale, Monroe County, WI will accept sealed bids for the following paving project on East Woody Drive (CTH PP to Jay St), and Jay Street (East Woody To Robin Drive). The bid includes overlay of the existing pavement with 1.5 inches of new Hot Mix Asphalt Pavement (4LT 58-28S) including all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to furnish and install AC pavement including saw cutting and asphalt removal for the driveways, existing pavement preparation, tack coat, asphaltic material, placement, compaction, testing, addition of gravel material as shoulder to compensate for the rise in the road profile. Additionally, the Village would like to ask the contractor to repair a dip in the pavement near the intersection of Jay Street and Robin Drive by removing a section of existing asphalt, adding gravel and prepare for paving.

Contract No 1:

The East Woody Dr project starting at route no. 1 which is CTH PP (Termini), with the offset of 85 feet (after concrete pavement), Toward Route: Jay St ((Termini), where the section length is 850 ft.

Contract No 2:

The Jay St project starting at route no. 2 which is East Woody Dr, Toward Route: Robin Dr where the section length is 370 ft.

The above project will be funded in part by Municipal Street Improvement component MSILT with LRIP project number 19868, and which is a component of the Local Roads Improvement Program (LRIP).

Bids will be accepted at the Village of Oakdale Office, 133 Well Drive, Tomah, WI 54660 until 4:30 PM on September 21, 2026. No bids will be accepted after 4:30 PM on September 21, 2026. Then on the same evening after 4:30 pm the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud during the Village Board meeting. Bids may be awarded during the meeting or postponed until the next Village Board meeting to give the board adequate time to review bids. The Village of Oakdale reserves the right to reject any or all bids or any part(s) thereof, waive any informality in the bidding process and to accept the bid proposal or portion of a bid proposal deemed most advantageous to the Village of Oakdale. Bids shall be directed to the Village Clerk securely sealed in an envelope and endorsed "BIDS FOR EAST WOODY PROJECT".
