VILLAGE OF POPLAR SEWER COMMISSION MEETING
June 4, 2019

The Sewer Commission Meeting was called to order by Chairman Randy Jones at 6:35 p.m.

SPEAKER: Bob Jauch has spoken to Governor Evers and Senator Janet Bewely regarding the issues that Poplar Sewer is facing with working with FEMA to get the damages that were done to the sewer pond repaired. The governor was shocked at the high sewer rates. A suggestion that was made was to resubmit engineering bids to FEMA. Randy Jones has received a quote from Aquatic Restoration Service of \$23, 650.00. This would be for work done to clean the pond. Randy Jones would like MSA to help with the bidding process.

OPERATOR'S REPORT: The final pond was isolated. On May 27, 2019, samples were taken and the BOD was 4.6 and the Phosphorus was 2.9. The readings were within normal range. Scott has been in contact with the people who are fixing the motor for Lift Station #4. The motor is fixed.
