AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE MANNER OF PAYMENT OF THE SALARY FOR THE CLERK-TREASURER OF THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Ohio, two-thirds of all members thereof concurring as follows:

- SECTION 1. That the salary of the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Ripley, Ohio shall be paid as follows:
- (A) an amount equivalent to six months thereof to be paid from the General Fund;
- (B) an amount equivalent to two months thereof to be paid from the Electric Fund;
- (C) an amount equivalent to two months thereof to be paid from the Sewer Fund;
- (D) an amount equivalent to one month thereof to be paid from the Water Fund; and
- (E) an amount equivalent to one month thereof to be paid from the Waste Fund;
- SECTION 2. That Ordinance No. 944, to the extent inconsistent herewith and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same hereby are repealed.
- SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of said Village and its inhabitants, and more particularly for the reason that the orderly affairs of government require that the Village secure and retain competent personnel to fulfill the duties of said position and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
