

ORDINANCE NO. 1030

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO TO  
MAKE APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL  
RESOURCES FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN DEVELOPMENT OF THE  
RIVERFRONT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, by two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:


SECTION 1. That the Village of Ripley shall make application to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) for financial assistance under the NatureWorks Program for development of the river front in the Village of Ripley in the form of a grant to be accompanied by a local in kind contribution of \$25,000.00.

SECTION 2. That the local cost share of said project, being the sum of \$25,000.00, is hereby encumbered for purposes of the project.


SECTION 3. That the Administrator of the Village of Ripley shall be and hereby is authorized to submit said application to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) and execute a Project Agreement with ODNR.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio and more particularly for the reason that the Village of Ripley is in need of financial assistance to develop and improve the river front in said Village and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
