ORDINANCE NO. 1042

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A DISASTER RELIEF FUND FOR THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley, Ohio was declared a disaster area after the flood of 1997; and
WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley, Ohio has and will receive funding for repairs of Village services from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the State of Ohio
NOW BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all members thereof concurring, that:
SECTION 1. The Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Ripley, Ohio shall create an account designated Disaster Relief for the purposes of receiving and dispersing Federal and State funds as a result of the flood of 1997.
SECTION 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of said Village and its inhabitants, and more particularly to maintain the orderly affairs of government. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
