## ORDINANCE NO. 1062

## AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1999.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members concurring, that:

SECTION 1: To provide for the current expenses of this municipality for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1999, and pending the adoption of a permanent annual appropriations ordinance, the following sums are hereby appropriated:

General Police\$	60,000.00
General Services\$	30,000.00
Cops Grant\$	20,000.00
Street Fund\$	21,000.00
State Highway\$	1,000.00
Cemetery Fund\$	7,000.00
Law Enforcement\$	1,000.00
Educate & Enforce\$	1,000.00
Voted Fire Levy\$	35,000.00
Water Fund\$	50,000.00
Sewer Fund\$	60,000.00
Electric Fund\$	302,000.00
Meter Deposit Fund\$	5,000.00
Waste Fund\$	37,000.00
Total Appropriations\$	675,000.00

Section 2: The treasurer of this municipality is authorized to issue payment on behalf of the municipality for the amount appropriated in this ordinance, whenever claims are presented, properly approved for which the indebtedness was incurred.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be deemed repealed upon the adoption of a permanent appropriations ordinance for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1999, but no expenditure made in accordance herewith shall be affected thereby.

Section 4: This ordinance is an emergency measure to provide for the usual daily operation of municipal government and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
