AN ORDINANCE ENCUMBERING FUNDS FOR OUTDOOR EARLY WARNING SIRENS FOR THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO .

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley has received funding from the State of Ohio, for Outdoor Early Warning Sirens, and


WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley desires to partially fund the sirens,

NOW BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all members concurring, that:


SECTION 1: The Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Ripley, Ohio shall encumber the amount of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) from the general fund to be used exclusively for Outdoor Early Warning Sirens.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of said Village and its inhabitants, and more particularly to maintain the orderly affairs of government. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
