VILLAGE OF RIPLEY OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 304

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF VILLAGE PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the Village of Ripley owns a garbage truck, namely a 1996 International Model 490 Trash Truck, VIN 1HTSHAAROTH240128 (the "Garbage Truck");

WHEREAS, the Garbage Truck is no longer needed for municipal purposes by the Village of Ripley; and

WHEREAS, the estimated value of the Garbage Truck is in excess of \$1,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Ripley, State of Ohio, by a vote of majority of all members elected to the legislative authority:

SECTION 1: That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code sec. 721.15(A), the legislative authority of the Villge of Ripley hereby authorizes the sale of the Garbage Truck at public auction on commercially reasonable terms subject to approval by the Village Administrator. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code sec. 721.15(A), the Village Administrator shall first advertise that the Garbage Truck will be publicly auctioned and the details thereof for at least two but not more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality. The Village Administrator shall accept the highest and best bid for the Garbage Truck. The bid shall be reduced to writing such that there is a written contract for the sale of the Garbage Truck, and the Village Administrator shall complete the sale on such terms.

SECTION 2: This is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety in the Village of Ripley, and for the further reason of obtaining additional revenue in order to continue to provide vital services to the residents of the Village.
