

ORDINANCE NO. 1007

ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF POAGE'S ALLEY
IN THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, OHIO
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION I. That the Village vacate that portion of Poage's Alley extending southwesterly from the southwesterly line of Second Street to a point twenty-five feet southwesterly of the southwesterly line of First Alley (vacated 02-11-41 Ordinance No. 186). Said Poage's Alley the first alley parallel and southeasterly of Main Street.

SECTION II. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio, and more particularly to provide for vacating the foregoing alley in the Village of Ripley, Ohio and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
