ORDINANCE NO. 1025

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION
FOR THE VILLAGE OF RIPLEY, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission for Brown County, Ohio has issued an Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources dated May 14, 1996 for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1996 for the Village of Ripley, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in order to provide for the orderly affairs of government and to provide for the usual daily operation of this municipality that a supplemental appropriation be made based on said Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources to appropriate funds not heretofore appropriated,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Ripley, Brown County, Ohio two-thirds (2/3) or more of all members thereof concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated the additional revenues as set forth in the Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources received from the Budget Commission of Brown County previously unappropriated as follows:

150-000-299	Downtown Revitalization Grant	\$725,000.00


