New Project Information & Criteria

NYF is designed to fund shovel-ready, transformational projects that have the potential to create an immediate, positive effect on a community's downtown. Communities must demonstrate a total of \$6-8M in projects - funding cannot go to one sole project.

- Funding may be awarded to public, private, and not-for-profit entities
- Project sponsors must have the capacity and legal authority to undertake the proposed project and must have site control or be in the process of obtaining site control
- Projects with a private sponsor must match a minimum of 25% of the total project cost
- There is no minimum match requirement for public or not-for-profit projects

The Local Planning Committee may impose higher match requirements as part of the planning process

- These will be smaller projects focused more on building renovation and redevelopment and activation of upper-stories (ex: housing, additional commercial) rather than new construction
- However, projects must be large enough to be truly transformative at least \$75,000 in total project costs
- Consider projects that elevate specific cultural, historical qualities that enhance the feeling of small-town charm
- · Projects must be able to break ground in 2 years
