Minimum Information Standards. An application for a small wind energy system shall be accompanied with the plans/information outlined below. The Zoning Administrator may waive one (1) or more of the requirements when it is deemed unnecessary for the review of a particular type of small wind energy system.

- ☐ Wind energy system description and maps showing the location of all proposed wind energy facilities.
- ☐ Technical description of wind turbines and wind turbine sites.
- ☐ Timeline and process for constructing the wind energy system.
- ☐ Information regarding anticipated impact of the wind energy system on local infrastructure.
- ☐ Information regarding noise anticipated to be attributable to wind energy system. Provide dBA generated.
- ☐ Information regarding the shadow flicker anticipated to be attributable to the wind energy system.
- ☐ Information regarding the anticipated effects of the wind energy system on existing land uses adjacent to the wind energy system.
- ☐ Information regarding the anticipated effects of the wind energy system on airports and airspace.
- ☐ Information regarding the anticipated effects of the wind energy system on line-of-sight communications.
- ☐ A list of all state and federal permits requires to construct and operate the wind energy system.
- ☐ Information regarding the planned use and modifications of roads during the construction, operation, and decommissioning of the wind energy system, including a process for assessing road damage caused by wind energy system activities and for conducting road repairs at the owner's expense.

A representative copy of all notices issued under Wis. State Statutes PSC 128.105(1) and 128.42(1) which are the following:

- ☐ PSC 128.105(1): Pre-application notice - At least 60 days before an owner files an application to construct a wind energy system, and owner shall use commercially reasonable methods to provide written notice of the planned wind energy system to all the following:
 - ☐ (a) Adjacent landowners within one mile of the planned wind turbine host property.
 - ☐ (b) Political subdivision within which the wind energy system may be located.
 - ☐ (c) Emergency first responders and air ambulance service providers serving a political subdivision within which the wind energy system may be located.
