Sewer and Water Utility News

During 2022, the Village completed installing new meters to every utility customer. The new technology provides helpful information on usage and water leaks. You can install the **Eye on Water** app to monitor your usage and be notified of water leaks. To sign up you will need your Utility Account Number and a valid email address.

Utility bills are sent at the end of each calendar quarter and are due on the 20th of the following month.

- Quarter 4 2022 bills will be sent by 12/31/2022 and are due **1/20/2023**
- Quarter 1 2023 bills will be sent by 3/31/2023 and are due **4/20/2023**
- Quarter 2 2023 bills will be sent by 6/30/2023 and are due **7/20/2023**
- Quarter 3 2023 bills will be sent by 9/30/2023 and are due **10/20/2023**
- Quarter 4 2023 bills will be sent by 12/31/2023 and are due **1/20/2024**

The Village has applied to Public Service Commission of Wisconsin and a 4.5% increase to water and sewer rates will begin Quarter 1 2023.

How to Pay the Village of Theresa

Payment can be made at Village Hall by cash or check (payable to Village of Theresa). If paying by cash, please have the exact amount.

Credit or Debit Card payments for Utility Accounts can be made online from the Village website (<https://villageoftheresa.com>)

Using the AllPaid icon.

There is also a drop box at the parking lot exit of Village Hall for any payments or documents for the Village of Theresa.

Dog Registrations

Registrations for 2023 can be submitted starting December 20, 2022. Fees:

- \$10 spayed/neutered
- \$15 not spayed/neutered

There is a \$25 late fee due for each dog not registered by March 31, 2023.

Proof of current rabies vaccination is needed for all dog registrations. Rabies information will be returned to the pet owner with the registration and tag.

Election Information

Elections are held in the Meeting Room at Village Hall, 292 Mayville Street. The easiest way to register to vote, change your name or address, or request an absentee ballot is by using <https://myvote.wi.gov>. However, forms are also available in the Village Hall entrance. The polls are open from 7 am – 8 pm for each Election.

Winter Parking

The Village restricts parking on Milwaukee Street from the North Village limits to the South Village limits for longer than 30 minutes between 2 am – 6 am from November 1 to April 1 (exemption for emergency vehicles). On all other streets, there is alternate parking on even calendar days on the side of the street with even house numbers and on odd calendar days there will be parking on the side of the street with odd house numbers. A winter parking permit for residents can be purchased for \$35.00 and can be found on the website or in the Village Hall entrance.

Sewer Mains and Laterals

The Village will continue with televising of sewer mains and laterals. Many laterals have damage from roots or materials that are failing due to age. Infiltration of water enters the system and is causing the Waste Water Treatment Plant to treat this water. It is necessary for the Village to continue this program in order to meet Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources requirements.

Do I now have a new pick-up schedule and when can I start using my carts?

Your pick-up day is Tuesday, recycling is every other week. Your first service day will be Tuesday, January 3rd, 2023 for both trash and recycle.

- (1) 95-gallon trash cart (blue cart with BLACK lid)
- (1) 95-gallon recycling cart (blue cart with GREEN lid)

Can I place my recyclables in plastic bags?

NO, DO NOT place recyclables in plastic bags or put bags-of-bags in your cart.

What should I do if my trash and recycle does not fit in my cart?

- Save them for your next collection day.
- Ask a neighbor if they have extra room in their cart for your trash or recycle.
- Call Harter's to rent an additional trash or recycle cart for a yearly fee.

Can I take my carts with me if I move?

No. Each cart should stay with the property. These carts are the property of Harter's, for cart repair or rental of additional cart; please call **(833) 754-2158**.

How do I set my cart out on collection day?

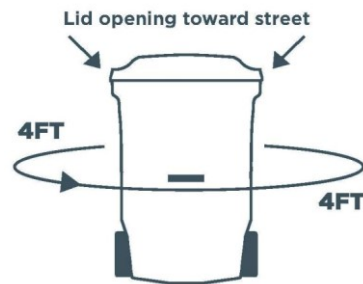
Place your cart curbside before 6 am the day of collection, with the cart's handle facing your house and the lid opening toward the street. All solid waste **MUST** be bagged. Make sure there is at least four feet between the recycling and trash carts, and any other objects, such as a parked car or mailbox. Note, if your carts were set out late, you must wait until your next scheduled pick-up.

What if there is a snow bank?

In the case of snow, if your cart will not fit in your driveway opening, then you will need to clear an opening in the snow bank where the cart can be properly placed. Carts cannot be placed on top of the snow bank or in the road. Improperly placed carts will not be collected.

How do Holiday's affect my pick-up?

Holiday collection will be delayed one day, if the Holiday is on a weekday before your pick-up day. Holidays are New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day
