

**ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 17.0213  
OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WALES,  
WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF WALES, WAUKESHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 17.1502 of the Village Code of the Village of Wales is amended to add the following definition:

Garage Sale or Rummage Sale. Is an occasional sale by individuals of accumulated items of personal property, most commonly within a household and no longer having utility thereto. Includes all general sales, open to the public, conducted from or on a residential premises in any residential zone, as defined by the Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Section 17.0213 of the Village Code of the Village of Wales is hereby created to read as follows:

Garage Sale or Rummage Sale. The owner of any property within the Village which is not zoned commercial, pursuant to Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code, may conduct no more than three rummage or garage sales, during any calendar year, on premises owned by the seller (or leaser), and any such sale shall be limited to a period of not more than 72 consecutive hours within any one week. A week shall be deemed to commence on any Monday.

A Conditions of Operations. All garage sales are confined within the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and promptly at the conclusion of any garage sale / rummage sale, all remaining personal property shall be returned to and stored within the permanent structures on the premises. No sale may be conducted in such a manner so as to obstruct any sidewalk, street, traffic sign, or safe view of an intersection.

B Signs. Shall not exceed 6 square feet per face may be erected on the premises for a period not to exceed 3 days, three times in any calendar year. Off-premise directional signs shall not exceed 6 square feet per face and shall be removed immediately after the event has been concluded. Such sale and directional signs shall not be illuminated.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with or contravening the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
