

Ordinance regarding driveway construction

Ordinance #1-2021 adopted by Waconia Township Board on _____, 2021, and filed with the Carver County Law Library.

Whereas, the drainage of water from private property that is directed onto graveled Township roads is detrimental to the proper maintenance of said roads, and,

Whereas, asphalt or concrete or other hard surfaced roads (including driveways) that extend onto the township's right of way make it difficult to properly landscape these roads to direct drainage away from the road surface into proper drainage ditches, and,

Whereas, hard surfaced private roads and driveways entering onto a gravel township road and extending beyond the township right of way, up to the edge of the gravel road are a hazard and impediment to proper snow removal,

Therefore be it resolved that, after June 1, 2021, this ordinance prohibits the establishment, construction, or resurfacing of any hard surfaced (asphalt or concrete or similarly surfaced) driveway or private road extending onto the gravel township road right of way.
