Storm Drain - Any water that enters the storm drain system – including water that carries sediment, oil, grease, and other pollutants, - discharges into our creeks and eventually enters the Great Salt Lake. Improperly managed stormwater runoff is a leading cause of flooding which can lead to property damage, causes road hazards, and clogs catch basins and culverts. Typically, the only thing that can be discharged into our storm water is rainwater. If you see someone dumping material into the gutter or down the storm drain catch basin, report it to the city at 801/292-4486 or the 24 hour dispatch line at 801/298-6000


Interested residents are entitled to one 9-hole round of golf with a cart. Golfers will need to show driver's license or proof of WB City residency. Call 801/295-1019

Doug and Laurie met in 1976 at Utah State University while Doug was majoring in Theatre and Laurie was majoring in Music. They married in September of 1977 and now have 5 children and 7 grandchildren. They have lived in West Bountiful for the past 18 years.

Over the past 40 years, they have performed in community theatre productions (Rogers Memorial Theatre) either individually, together, or with their children. For some of the productions, Doug was the director. Part of Doug's career was as a Story Board Artist. During his animation years, he was privileged to win an Emmy as a Director for Muppet Babies.
