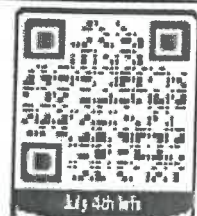

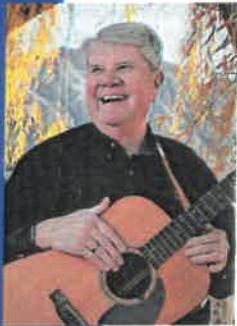
### 2023 Parade Grand Marshal

**Mike Murphy** He is well known in the South Davis area having been a teacher at Viewmont High School for 37 years, the owner of Murphy's Guitars for 14 years, a solo performer and a member of various rock and country bands in the area over the years, and a resident of West Bountiful for 43 years. Mike also began a 20 year tradition of the MS Unplugged Concert that began in 2000 and ended it's run in 2020, raising over \$60,000 for the MS Society during those years to help with research and the treatment of Multiple Sclerosis. It was through that concert that Mike began working with Guitarist/Singer/Songwriter Jake White, Singer/Songwriter Kat Tingey, Bass Player Jason White, and Drummer Jim Webster.



**Jake White** He has a unique guitar style that is patterned after Michael Hedges and has written and recorded many songs including the song "Memory Lane" that was used on one of the Especially For Youth music albums many years ago. Jake, with his brother Jason, has also opened for Peter Breinholt. He has one film credit to his name for his rendition of "Battle Hymn of the Republic" that was used in a scene on the Hollywood produced movie "W" about George W. Bush and the beginning of the war in the Middle East. Lately, Jake has been writing a tribute book about the late Michael Hedges and has interviewed the family of Michael and even got to play Michael's guitar.



**Jason White** is Jake White's younger brother and is an extremely talented Bass player who has played on many recordings by local musicians including Mike Murphy. Jason's day job is a web designer but he has a rehearsal studio in his home where he loves making music with friends and you will often find Kat Tingey or Mike Murphy and others in rehearsal for some upcoming gig.



**Jim Webster** is a Patent Attorney by trade but is the drum beat behind the band "Two Jacks and a Jill" featuring Kat Tingey and Jason White. Jim has also been part of "Mike Murphy and the Time Keepers" and has played on many of the MS Unplugged Concerts with Mike, Jason, Jake, and Kat along with other artists.

We are excited about the opportunity to play our music for the West Bountiful Independence Day celebration on July 3, 2023. We hope you enjoy the music.

### Summer Street Parking Reminders

After what felt like a never-ending winter, summer is finally here! Which means barbecues and gatherings with friends and family. Finding space to park cars for the festivities in your neighborhoods can be a challenge. We would rather not be the uninvited guests to your party (though we do love a good barbecue) so here are a few parking "no, no's" that will keep the food and traffic flowing.



### No parking...

Over a sidewalk.

Blocking a driveway.

With the left side to the curb (against traffic).

In any fire lane or redzone.

Within 20 feet of a crosswalk or 40 feet of an intersection.

Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.

Within 30 feet of a stop sign, yield sign, or flashing signal.
