### Notes from the Chief - Fall and Winter Preparations

It's the time of year where we transition from cool air conditioning to the warmth of our furnaces. Make sure you have tested your carbon monoxide alarms as well as smoke detectors to ensure the safety of yourself and others. While you're checking them, it's a great opportunity to change out the batteries before they inevitably start beeping in the middle of the night.

Vehicles should also be prepared for the winter weather we experience in Utah. Make sure your vehicles are winter road ready by having the right tires and air pressure, as well as checking the condition of your battery. We also recommend having an emergency road kit on hand with blankets, extra clothing, nonperishable foods, first aid kit, shovel, and emergency flares. If you find yourself stranded or stuck in the snow, stay with your vehicle and conserve fuel until help arrives.

Also, residents should be aware of the city over-night parking ordinance as well as the winter snow removal ordinance. City code 10.12.090 prohibits all night parking, defined as Midnight to 7 AM, from November 15th through April 1st. An exception is provided two days before and two days after the Thanksgiving and Christmas Holidays.

City code also prohibits parking a vehicle on the street anytime snow is visibly falling or there is a visible amount of snow in the street and the street has not been plowed since the snow fell.
