Business:

1. Mayor Madeline Stokes called the meeting to order at 5:07 p.m. and welcomed everyone to the meeting.

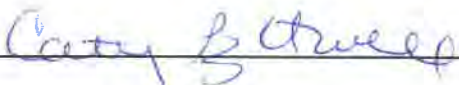
