

**West Bountiful
Youth City Council Meeting**

November 12, 2020

Minutes of the Youth City Council Meeting of West Bountiful City held on Thursday November 12, 2020. Due to the Coronavirus Pandemic, this meeting was held remotely via Zoom.

Business:

1. Mayor Sydney Morrill called the meeting to order at 5:04 pm and welcomed everyone to the meeting. She read the following statement: ***Mayor Romney and I, as Youth Mayor, have determined that due to the current COVID-19 pandemic and the physical distancing required to prevent the spread of infection, public meetings present a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the meetings. That risk can be substantially mitigated by holding Youth Council meetings through electronic means that allow for public participation without an anchor location.***
2. Becca Marsden provided a thought.
3. Tyson motioned to approve the minutes from October 22, 2020 as previously stated and Elsie Buck seconded that motion.
4. Tyson Wood gave us a treasury report that there were no new updates to the budget.
5. Bo Bartholomew motioned to approve the YCC 04-20, and Tyson Wood seconded that motion. The vote was unanimous in favor of approving.
6. We discussed Christmas on Onion Street scheduled for December 7. With COVID-19 cases surging, it will not be safe for all of us to be on the trailers so we will have fewer people – maybe family members in the same trucks. Nicole Wood is working on costumes. Also, talked about starting at 4:30 pm, playing Christmas music and driving slower through the city to give kids more time to see Santa. Cathy Brightwell will check to see if the fire truck is available for longer and James Ahlstrom will make arrangements for speakers so Christmas music can be played. Because kids can't come to city hall due to social distancing, we talked about having them send letters to Santa and we will hand-deliver responses. Bo Bartholomew will head up a committee to work on responses to the letters with help from Sydney. Information will be put on the city's social media, YCC social media, the website and the marquee.

7. We talked about the service project options for the Ronald McDonald house and Food Pantry. We talked about what the safest ways to do the service was and that we would probably only do one. These service projects will be done after the holidays.
8. We discussed the option of painting rocks for the Arts Council to put on the Prospector Trail.
9. We are planning on meeting on December 2, 2020 to discuss more about Christmas on Onion Street.
10. The meeting was adjourned at 5:48. Bo Bartholomew made a motion to Adjourn. Noah Peterson seconded that motion. Voting was unanimous in favor of the Motion.
