Business:

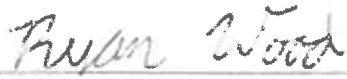
1. Mayor Sydney Morrill called the meeting to order at 5:05 pm and welcomed everyone to the meeting. She read the following statement: ***Mayor Romney and I, as Youth Mayor, have determined that due to the current COVID-19 pandemic and the physical distancing required to prevent the spread of infection, public meetings present a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present at the meetings. That risk can be substantially mitigated by holding Youth Council meetings through electronic means that allow for public participation without an anchor location.***
2. We skipped over this for a minute but then Noah Peterson provided a thought for us.
3. Bo Bartholomew motioned to approve the minutes from November 12, 2020 as previously stated and Tyson Wood seconded that motion.
4. Tyson Wood gave us a treasury report that there were \$50.98 of expenses for Christmas on Onion Street that were not in the budget yet.
5. We discussed how things went with Christmas on Onion Street. We discussed how the turnout for this year was compared to previous years and how there was still a good turnout even with a different way of what we were doing. We discussed how we will try to avoid going back to having hundreds of people in the City Hall and how things will still be different even if things get back to a more normal. We discussed how we might do Christmas on Onion Street on a Saturday afternoon when it is brighter and warmer and so more people will come out.
6. We then discussed how we want to send responses to the Santa Letters we received during Christmas on Onion Street. We discussed the option of returning letters with people in elf costumes. We also discussed doing it with Santa hats on. Cooper, Elsie, Noah, Sara, and Spencer said they would be willing to return the Santa Letters to the people who wrote them. We discussed about whether or not we should do many different responses or if we should do one letter combined with all of the current responses. We discussed about how when we deliver the

letters that we will need to stay distant and have masks so that we follow CDC rules. We said that Sydney will divvy up the letters and send them to people to deliver.

7. We discussed how we will deliver the food for the pantry and discussed the schedule of the food pantry. Bo Bartholomew was assigned to take the boxes for the food pantry to the food pantry. James Ahlstrom will take Bo Bartholomew to the city hall for the food pantry boxes.
8. There was no other business to discuss.
9. The meeting was adjourned at 5:35. Tyson Wood made a motion to Adjourn. Noah Peterson seconded that motion. Voting was unanimous in favor of the Motion.
