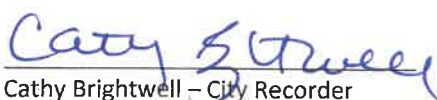
Business:

1. Mayor Pro Tem Elsie Buck called the meeting to order at 5:06 pm and welcomed everyone to the meeting.
1. Cooper Buck led the council in the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Noah Peterson shared the youth thought.
3. Approval of Minutes. Cooper Buck made a Motion to Approve the Minutes of the January 13, 2022, Youth City Council meeting as presented. Bo Bartholomew Seconded the Motion. Voting was unanimous in favor of the Motion
4. Treasurer's report: Cathy told the council that there are no current expenses. Our budget has gone from \$4,000 to \$6,000.
5. YCC Theme – "Not one but all, we make the change together." How can we make that a part of us? Bo suggested that in the Easter scramble, there can be activities that involve groups.
6. Racial Unity Presentation: The council discussed having this presentation April 28 as an extra meeting. There have been many community members who have experienced intense racism, so there is a presentation that the council can show to the community so people can stand up to racism. It was discussed to have added into our meetings.
7. Easter Egg Scramble (April 16): Some ideas for activities include team games, relay race, egg drop, balloon toss with eggs, minute to win it games, eggs that have numbers and there are prizes associated with the numbers. There needs to be 3,000-4,000 eggs. Every member needs to come to the next meeting with an idea for a game for the Easter Scramble.
8. Open Meeting Training: Cathy Brightwell went over the Utah Open and Public Meetings Act with the council.

10. Adjournment - Bo Bartholomew made a Motion to Adjourn. Drew Farley Seconded it. Voting was unanimous in favor of the Motion.
