Business:

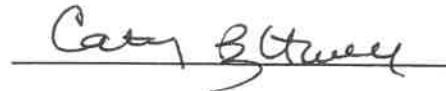
1. Mayor Elsie Buck called the meeting to order at 5:07 pm and welcomed everyone to the meeting.
