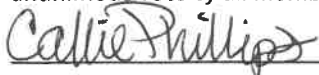

Business:

1. Mayor Elsie Buck called the meeting to order at 5:06 pm and welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2. Bo Bartholomew provided a thought and Spencer Lewis led the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Other Business: a) The Council will begin filling Easter eggs at the next meeting for the Easter egg scramble in April. The council discussed putting prizes in the gold eggs and having a place to claim the prizes. b) Mayor Romney is going to send a letter out to the Council member's parents about volunteering to help out as Youth Council advisors or provide suggestions for new advisors.

The Council thanked Ms. Kaiser for leading this informative discussion.
