Business:

1. Mayor Callie Phillips called the meeting to order at 2:15 pm; Bo Bartholomew led the Pledge of Allegiance, and Callie Phillips provided a thought.
2. Mayor Callie Phillips welcomed everyone to the meeting and members introduced themselves.
3. Cathy Brightwell and James Ahlstrom reviewed expectations for the Council. The Mission of the Council was reviewed.
4. Approval of Minutes. Bo Bartholomew made a Motion to Approve the Minutes of the April 27, 2023, Youth City Council meeting as presented. Ella Rodabough Seconded the Motion. Voting was unanimous in favor of the Motion.

Two members were asked to bring wagons to carry candy. Trailer/float will be decorated on Monday, July 3, at 3:30pm.

 - b. There was discussion on updating the bylaws in the fall.
 - c. Members discussed possible activities for the fall retreat. Ideas included Boondocks and Get Air.
