Business:

1. Mayor Callie Phillips called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm; Bo Bartholomew provided a thought and Noah Peterson led the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Approval of Minutes. Andrea Halling made a Motion to Approve the Minutes of the August 24, 2023 Youth City Council meeting as presented. Bo Bartholomew Seconded the Motion. Voting was unanimous in favor of the Motion.

 - c. Members were asked to choose a service project. They decided on putting together goody bags to take to hospitals. The bags will be assembled over several meetings.
