A public demonstration will be held to test the voting devices and tabulation equipment being used for the November General Election. Anyone desiring to witness the testing is invited to attend, beginning at 10:00 a.m. October 10, 2025 at the Davis County Administration Building - 61 South Main Street, Room #202 Farmington, UT.

All eligible voters will receive their ballot by mail approximately three weeks prior to Election Day.

The Polling Locations (listed below) will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day for any voter in Davis County to return their ballots or vote in person. Accessible voting machines are available.
