#### Winter Vehicle Safety & Parking Reminders for West Bountiful

As the temperatures drop, we know the urge to warm up your car before heading out is strong - but it's also one of the easiest ways for thieves to take advantage. Remember: it only takes seconds for someone to drive off in an unattended, running vehicle. A warm car isn't worth a cold call to your insurance company!

#### A Quick Safety Reminder:

- Never leave your vehicle running and unattended.
- Use a **remote start system** if you have one - it keeps your doors locked.
- Always **lock your doors**, even in your driveway.
- Keep valuables out of sight.
- Report any suspicious activity right away.



#### Winter Parking Alert: Keep Streets Clear and Cars Tow-Free!

Winter parking rules are here to keep streets safe and plow-ready. From **November 15 to April 1**, no street parking is allowed between **midnight and 7 a.m.** to help snowplows do their job efficiently.

#### Holiday Exceptions:

You can park overnight **two days before, on, and two days after** Thanksgiving and Christmas - and **New Year's Eve** is exempt too!

#### Snow Removal in Progress?

If it's snowing or plowing is underway, please move your car off the road. Even if plows aren't out yet, parked cars can block critical routes.

#### Notice & Towing Policy:

If a violation is observed, officers will leave a warning on your vehicle, you'll have **24 hours to comply!** After that, vehicles still in violation may be **towed at the owner's expense.**

By keeping vehicles off the streets and secured, we can all help ensure a safer, smoother winter season for everyone.

**Stay warm, stay safe, and thank you for helping keep West Bountiful's streets clear this winter!**

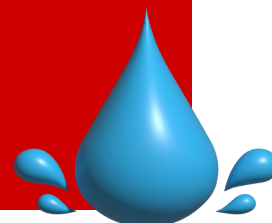

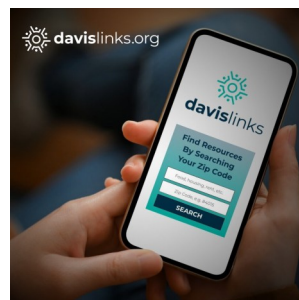
### WINTER REMINDERS!

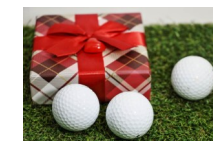

Thank you for participating in our recent municipal election. The city had a voter turn-out of 45.18%. This year's election featured races for the Mayor and two City Council seats. \*Voted in to fill the three open seats were incumbent Mayor Kenneth Romney, Councilmember Kelly Enquist, along with newly elected councilmember Julie Nichols Thompson. All three elected officials will begin their new terms in January 2026. Voters also approved the continuation of the RAP (Recreation, Arts and Parks) Tax for an additional 10 years.
