ORDINANCE #513-26

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING CHAPTER 2.34 OF THE WEST BOUNTIFUL MUNICIPAL CODE AND ALL ASSOCIATED YOUTH CITY COUNCIL BYLAWS FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS; ESTABLISHING INTERIM OPERATING STANDARDS FOR THE YOUTH CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that Chapter 2.34 of the West Bountiful Municipal Code governing the Youth City Council and the bylaws adopted pursuant thereto should be reviewed and updated to better serve the needs of the City and its youth participants; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to allow the Youth City Council program to continue operating during the review and redrafting process without interruption; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that temporary suspension of the existing chapter and bylaws, while establishing interim operating standards, serves the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of West Bountiful:

Section 1. Temporary Suspension

The provisions of Chapter 2.34, Youth City Council, and all bylaws, policies, procedures, officer requirements, membership requirements, attendance requirements, elections, and organizational provisions adopted pursuant thereto are hereby suspended for a period of six (6) months from the effective date of this Ordinance.

During the suspension period, such provisions shall have no force or effect except as specifically preserved by this Ordinance.

Section 2. Continuation of Youth City Council.

Notwithstanding the suspension of Chapter 2.34 and associated bylaws, the Youth City Council shall continue to operate as an advisory and service organization sponsored by the City.

The purpose of the Youth City Council during the suspension period shall be to:

- A. Promote youth leadership, civic engagement, volunteerism, and community service;
- B. Assist with City-sponsored youth and community events;
- D. Participate in projects approved by the City.

Section 3. Interim Operating Standards.

During the suspension period, the following operating standards shall be in place:

A. Membership.

1. Youth participants may be appointed or approved by the Mayor or the Mayor's designee.
2. The Mayor or designated advisor may establish reasonable participation expectations as needed for program administration.

B. Leadership.

1. The Youth City Council may operate with or without officers.
2. The Mayor or designated advisor may appoint youth participants to leadership roles as deemed appropriate.
3. Leadership assignments may be modified at any time during the suspension period.

C. Advisors.

1. The current city council representative and adult advisors may continue in current functions
2. The Mayor may appoint one or more adult advisors to supervise and administer the Youth City Council.
3. Advisors shall operate under the direction of the Mayor and City Council.


D. Meetings.

1. Meetings may be conducted in a manner determined by the Mayor or designated advisors.
2. Formal parliamentary procedures and bylaw requirements are suspended unless specifically required by law.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon signing and posting.




