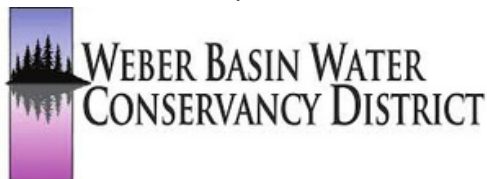

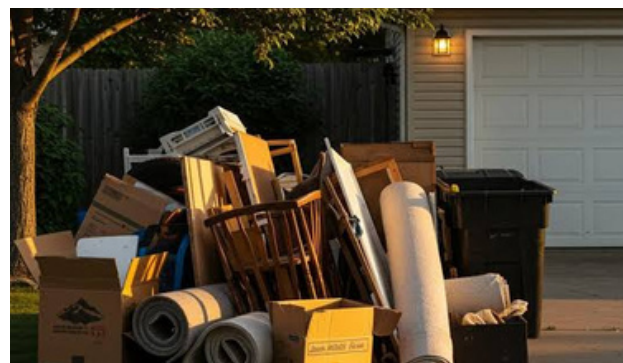

Halloween Safety & Trunk Or Treat

Halloween is a fun night for families, and a little preparation can help keep everyone safe while enjoying the evening.

When trick-or-treating, children should stay with a responsible adult or group, use sidewalks whenever possible, and cross streets at marked crosswalks or intersections. Drivers should use extra caution in residential neighborhoods, slow down, and watch closely for children who may enter the roadway unexpectedly.

Costumes should be easy to see after dark. Reflective material, flashlights, and glowsticks can all help make trick-or-treaters more visible to drivers. Masks and costumes should also fit properly so they do not interfere with a child's vision or create a tripping hazard.

Before eating any treats, parents should take a moment to check candy and other items to make sure packaging is intact and appropriate for their children.

West Bountiful City will also be hosting our **Trunk or Treat on October 31 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at West Bountiful City Hall**. We hope families will stop by and enjoy a safe and fun evening with the community.
