RESOLUTION F 19 CITY OF WENDELL MORATORIUM

WHEREAS, the city sewer system does not comply with the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare regulations dealing with disposal requirements because the system is inadequate to handle the volume generated by the residents of the City and;

WHEREAS, the city sewer system periodically overflows the lagoon system because the system is inadequate to handle the volume generated within the City of Wendell, and,

WHEREAS, the overflow of the lagoon system poses an imminent danger to the public health;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Wendell does hereby declare an emergency moratorium on all new building construction which would be required to connect to the existing sewer system for a period of one hundred twenty days (120), commencing March 13, 1986. Said emergency moratorium is declared pursuant to the provisions of Idaho Code Section 67-6523.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that all persons who have currently applied for a building permit to connect to the existing sewer system shall be excluded from this moratorium.
