APPEAL PERIOD TO OPEN FOR PROPOSED FEMA FLOOD HAZARD DETERMINATIONS

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) is proposing revised Flood Insurance Rate Maps for the Town of Windsor Locks. The maps are due to become effective in November of 2025. The impact of these new maps may include additions or modifications of special flood hazard areas, changes in base flood elevations or depths, and flood zone designation changes.

On or about February 21, 2024 and February 28, 2024, FEMA published notice of the proposed flood hazard determinations in the Hartford Courant. The significance of the publication is to start a 90-day appeal period, beginning February 28, 2024. Any owner or lessee of real property who believes his or her property rights will be adversely affected by the proposed flood hazard determinations may file an appeal. The sole basis for an appeal is the possession of knowledge or information indicating that the proposed flood hazard determinations are scientifically or technically incorrect.

Property owners are encouraged to review the preliminary maps at the FEMA Flood Map Service Center online here.
