MINUTES OF TOWN MEETING

Pursuant to the foregoing notice, a Town Meeting of the electors and those qualified to vote at Town meetings of the Town of Windsor Locks, Connecticut was held at the Windsor Locks Town Hall in the Ella Grasso Room on Thursday, March 12, 2026, at 7:30PM.

I. Call to Order

- a. The Honorable First Selectman Jon Savino, called the Town Meeting to order at 7:30PM in the Ella Grasso room located at Windsor Locks Town Hall.

II. Reading of the Call

- a. Christopher Latournes, Town Clerk read the reading of the Call.

III. Nomination of a Moderator

- a. First Selectman Jon Savino entertained the nomination of a moderator at which time Mark Whitten (*31 Acorn Drive*) **MOVED** to nominate Mr. Joseph Calsetta (*121 Orchard Hill Drive*) seconded by Patty Murphy (*2 Tinker Drive*), which passed by voice vote with one opposed. **MOTION CARRIES.**

IV. New Business

1. Moderator Joseph Calsetta asked for the introduction of a resolution coming before the floor at which time First Selectman Jon Savino **MOVED** for the adoption of the following resolution **SECONDED** by Patty Murphy (*2 Tinker Drive*).

BE IT RESOLVED, that that Town of Windsor Locks, acting herein by Town Meeting approves the use of unallocated capital funds in the amount of \$14,000 for a Senior Center Bus as recommended by the Board of Selectmen and Board of Finance.

- a. The Moderator opened the floor for discussion.
- b. Resident Linda Palmer (*15 North Main Street*) wanted to let people know that their taxes are going to go up due to this bus purchase. This isn't the only department that's going to be requesting money over their budget and other departments have been requesting budget increases between thirteen and fifteen percent and were already 5.8 million dollars over budget.
- c. Board of Finance Chairperson Patty Murphy (*2 Tinker Drive*) explained that this money is coming from unallocated capitals, which is money that has already been set aside for projects and is left over from projects that were already finished. Murphy stated that taxes will not go up due to this money being allocated.
- d. Being no additional discussion, Moderator Joseph Calsetta called for a vote on the original resolution which was passed by voice vote with one opposition.
