FROM THE DESK OF THE FIRST SELECTMAN

Hello, Seniors!

This summer is flying by and before we know it, fall will be here. There's quite a bit happening in Windsor Locks, and I'd like to share a few important updates.

Main Street Transformation

The building at **255 Main Street** has now been fully demolished as part of our long planned revitalization of Main Street. This project will make way for new apartments and retail space, bringing fresh energy and opportunity to the heart of town.

Our historic train station is also taking shape, and we're looking forward to a grand opening in the near future. We hope to include a welcome center and possibly a coffee shop in that space—both of which would bring new life to this important landmark.

Fire Department Engineering Study

The State of Connecticut has awarded Windsor Locks a **\$250,000 grant** to fund an engineering study of our aging Fire Department building. This study will determine whether renovation is feasible or if a full rebuild is necessary. Ensuring our firefighters have a safe, modern facility remains a top priority.

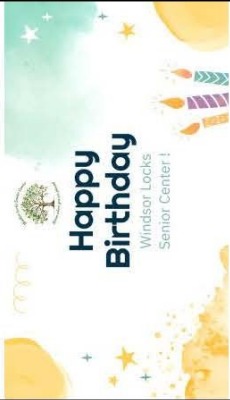

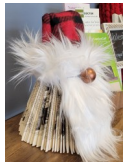
