INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Animal Complaint - Injured Deer	2019-12-02	Officer responded to a report of an injured deer. RP stated deer had what appeared to be a broken leg. Deer had gone into thick woods and could not be found. Advised to call back if the deer returned.
Parking Complaint	2019-12-03	While on patrol officer observed resident in vehicle with window down, speaking with semi truck driver and gesturing to get officer's attention. Officer spoke to driver who said he'd been there less than 10 minutes to unload equipment and had temporarily blocked the road when the resident stopped and was upset with him. Driver explained to her he was leaving and said she was still upset and asking questions about who pays him. Officer later advised resident via phone that the driver was attempting to leave when she stopped and would not be back until the following day to pick up the equipment.
Identity Theft	2019-12-05	Victim called to report fraudulent activity on his debit card, unlawful use of his Social Security Card and Driver's License. The suspect used the victims Driver's License, with a fake

			picture to purchase a vehicle in Florida. The suspect also opened an Insurance Policy through Progressive Insurance to insure the fraudulent purchase of the vehicle. There has been no monetary loss at this time. RP advised he has a credit monitoring service and they are watching his finances and social security number.
Traffic Stop - Verbal Warning		2019-12-07	Verbal Warning - Stop Sign
Hit Deer		2019-12-10	Officer dispatched to a hit deer at a residence. Officer arrived on scene and observed a half decayed deer that was on private property. Officer informed the reporting party that because the deer is on private property it's the property owner's responsibility to remove the deer.
Alarm - Residential		2019-12-13	Officer was dispatched to a residential alarm at the listed residence. Officer was cancelled prior to arrival.
Parking Complaint		2019-12-15	An officer was dispatched to a parking complaint in Woodland, the officer found a parking permit on file for a resident off of Woolsey Lane. The officer checked the area and found fifty to one hundred vehicles parked on the north side of Breezy Point Road, valet approached and said they were working to get people out of the area and the party was almost over. The officer attempted to contact the permit holder with no answer. The officer monitored the area and later found the parking condensed down to one parking zone.

Open Door		2019-12-18	Officer dispatched to an open door, the residence appeared undisturbed. The RP stated occasionally the house keeper stays over when they are out of town. Officer found the housekeepers vehicle on the premises and cleared. Officer advised the RP via voicemail.
Alarm - Residential		2019-12-18	Officer dispatched to a residential alarm. Officer checked residence and found home owner on scene, false trip. Alarm card left on scene.

Medical	2019-12-25	Officer responded to the listed residence for a medical. Officer arrived and collected information while assessing the patient. Wayzata FD arrived and took over patient care.
Domestic - Verbal	2019-12-25	Officer was dispatched to a domestic at the listed residence. Officer gathered information and separated the parties involved for the night.

Road Conditions	2019-12-31	Officer was on routine patrol when Officer noticed bad road conditions at the listed intersection. Officer called Woodland plow to come out and salt the roads and plow.
