INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Alarm - Residential	2022-07-05	Officer was dispatched to a residential alarm. Officer requested assistance from Minnetonka Police Department. Officer and Minnetonka PD Officer observed an individual with a flash light in the 1st floor window along with a 2nd individual in the second-floor window. Officer attempted contact at the front door and received no answer. Officer requested a perimeter of the residence and K9 assistance. Officers gave announcements and the homeowner came to the door. Officer identified the homeowner and verified it was a false alarm.
Tree Down - Blocking	2022-07-05	An officer was dispatched to a tree down on Maple Hill Road in Woodland, officer found a tree partially blocking the road. Shorewood Tree Service was contacted and later removed the tree.
Road Debris	2022-07-05	Officer was dispatched to large boulders in the middle of the roadway. Officer moved boulders.
Medical	2022-07-08	An officer and CSO was dispatched to a Medical. Officers arrived on scene and administered O2 to patient. Family decided to self-transport to Methodist and Hennepin EMS was cancelled.

Directed Patrol	2022-07-09	An officer conducted directed patrol of Breezy Point Road for speed, no violations observed.
Directed Patrol	2022-07-10	Directed patrol in area. No violations observed.
Ordinance Violation - No Tree Permit	2022-07-11	A resident reported a company was removing trees at a residence on Maplewood Road and dropping trees on the roadway. An officer located no company on site but did find a tree leaning towards Maplewood Road that had been cut half way through near the base and in danger of falling into a power line. It appeared the company intended to fall the tree onto the roadway and across the neighbor's driveway. The tree was deemed a danger, Shorewood Tree Service was contacted at the request of the City of Woodland and removed the tree. Unable to contact the Tree Service doing the removal.
Traffic Stop - Verbal Warning	2022-07-13	Traffic Stop - Verbal Warning for holding cellphone while engaging in phone call. Driver was confused on law, holding phone while on speaker phone.
Fire Alarm - Residential	2022-07-15	Officers were dispatched to a residential fire alarm. Upon arrival it was determined to be set off by construction going on.
Medical	2022-07-17	An officer was dispatched to one who went unconscious in the Assembly Grounds Meeting house in Woodland, the patient went unconscious and fell causing facial injuries. The patient was cared for by Wayzata Fire Department and Hennepin Health Care prior to being transported to Methodist Hospital.
Suspicious Activity	2022-07-18	A resident of Woodland called to report a suspicious male with a high visibility vest in a vehicle video recorded their children on Gale Road while they were biking the day prior. Resident wanted the police department to be aware.
Directed Patrol	2022-07-18	An officer conducted directed patrol of Breezy Point Road for speed, no violations observed.
Directed Patrol	2022-07-19	An officer conducted directed patrol of Breezy Point Road for speed, no violations observed.
Wire Down	2022-07-19	An officer was dispatched to a wire arcing in the Assembly Grounds in Woodland, when the officer arrived the wire arced and fell with the power going out at several homes. Wayzata Fire surveyed the area and Xcel later responded and restored service.
Welfare Check	2022-07-20	Officer dispatched to a welfare check of a woman walking that appeared to be intoxicated. Officer located the subject and found her to elderly and not intoxicated. RP was advised.
Alarm - Residential	2022-07-20	Officer dispatched to a residential alarm. Officer checked residence and found contractor on scene, false trip. Alarm

			card left on scene.
Information - Ordinance Violation		2022-07-20	RP informed dispatch that a tree was cut down near the listed intersection that was not supposed to be. RP stated that this was an ordinance violation. Officer tried contacting the RP via phone call but could not make contact. Officer left a voicemail requesting a call back, but never received a call.
Alarm - Residential - Cancelled		2022-07-20	Officers were dispatched to a residential alarm at listed address. Officers were cancelled while enroute.
